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Thank you for your interest in registering your lupine-type dog under the Lupine Dog breed development with the World of Lupines Foundation (W.O.L.F.).

This enables you to prove and improve the quality of your wolf-alike/wolfdogs by providing a registration system of health and temperament tested dogs for ethical breeders. This pack will aim to guide you through the application process and highlight some of the benefits of being a W.O.L.F. registered breeder. Dogs who pass this application process will be eligible to use the trademarked name 'Lupine Dog' as long as they remain in our database.

### Benefits

- If your dog passes assessment, you will be sent a W.O.L.F. PEDIGREE CERTIFICATE and unique registration number for your dog, as well as a breeder 'Welcome Pack' which guides you through our services & explains how to register your puppies with us/ advertise your stud with us
- You may use the Trademarked name 'Lupine Dog' for dogs who carry our pedigree certificates/registration numbers. Note: This name remains our property and we reserve the right to remove permission for use if our Code of Ethics is breached
- To register a dog, you must also be a breeder member of W.O.L.F. which will grant a registered W.O.L.F. Affix. You will be able to advertise your litters on our website and social media resources
- You will be able to use our W.O.L.F. logo in your advertising
- As soon as you know you would like to breed, you can (if you wish) contact our experts for advice on pedigree and mate selection or for any advice regarding the breeding of Lupine Dogs
- You will be able to register offspring from your Foundation Dog with W.O.L.F. provided the dam of the litter has full W.O.L.F. Lupine or Foundation Dog registration. The sire should ideally be a registered Lupine or Foundation Dog but can be an outside stud. Outside studs must provide proof of passing all the required health testing for W.O.L.F. registered dogs including Embark DNA testing
- Puppy owners will receive a pedigree certificate with W.O.L.F. registration by official stamp, puppy welcome pack and access to our advice services and online community
- Your dog will be eligible to enter the Registered Lupine Dog classes for registered dogs at our conformation shows
- Your dog's basic info can be displayed on our website and media as proof of their quality

## Is my dog eligible?

Registration is open to wolf-alike and wolfdogs with a minimum of 3-generation pedigree information.

- Any natural type dog breed may be eligible if they achieve 70% or more of our Lupine Dog Breed Standard
- The owner must be a member of W.O.L.F.
- A maximum hip score of B/B FCI, or BVA, OFA Equivalent. PennHIP Below 0.3
- SOD1 (Degenerative Myelopathy) result clear OR carrier (NOTE: CARRIER offspring will only be eligible for puppy registration if bred with a CLEAR mate)
- LHX3 (Dwarfism) OR where required OSD3 result clear OR carrier (NOTE: CARRIER offspring will only be eligible for puppy registration if bred with a CLEAR mate)
- A clear annual Eye Examination by a Veterinary Ophthalmologist or via DNA result where required
- An Embark Genetic Test to include Breed Identification
- A pass result of the W.O.L.F. Temperament and Behaviour Evaluation
- The Breeder must abide by our 'Code of Ethics'

## How to apply: The Dog Assessment Process:

- Firstly, before you can register your dog, you as a breeder/owner must be a member of W.O.L.F. with a registered Affix (Kennel Name)

*Please note: A dog is registered on the W.O.L.F. Database in partnership with a W.O.L.F. membership/affix – it cannot be transferred to another owner. A new owner must apply for the dog in their own W.O.L.F. MEMBERSHIP/AFFIX.*

- You must make yourself aware of our Breed Standard, Code of Ethics and our Constitution, all of which can be found on our website, and you must have a valid W.O.L.F. breeder membership. CAUTION: breaches in our Codes of Ethics will be taken very seriously and may result in removal of member certification and/or dog registration
- With your veterinarian, fill in the forms included in this pack
- You must provide verifiable evidence that your dog has passed a variety of health tests

*Please Note: Although it can be done at home, ideally, we require any DNA swab to be done by your veterinarian to verify the dog's identity and W.O.L.F. reserve the right to request this action if concerns are raised over the authentication of any DNA results*

Send the below forms, together with copies of health documentation, known 3-generation pedigree and Lupine Temperament/Behaviour Evaluation, back to us with a one-off £10.00 application fee - applies for the lifetime of the dog unless a change of ownership occurs. In which case the dog must be re-registered under the new owner details where an admin fee will apply
