Thank you for your interest in registering your natural-type dog for the Lupine Dog breed development with the World of Lupines Foundation (W.O.L.F.).

This enables you and us to prove and improve the quality of dogs by providing a registration system for health and temperament tested dogs within the Lupine Dog breed standard. This document will help guide you through the application process and highlight some of the benefits of being a W.O.L.F. registered breeder. Dogs who pass this application process will be eligible to use the trademarked name 'Lupine Dog'.

Benefits

- W.O.L.F. Pedigree Certificate and unique registration number for each dog, as well as a breeder 'Welcome Pack' which guides you through our services & explains how to register your puppies and/or advertise your stud dog.
- You may use the Trademarked name 'Lupine Dog' for dogs who carry a W.O.L.F. pedigree certificate and registration number. Note: This name remains our property and we reserve the right to remove permission for use if our Code of Ethics is breached.
- To register a dog, you must also be a breeder member of W.O.L.F. which will grant a registered W.O.L.F. Affix and breeder registration number. You will be able to advertise your litters on our website and all social media platforms.
- You will be able to use our W.O.L.F. logo in your advertising.
- As soon as you know you would like to breed, you can (if you wish) contact our experts
 for advice on pedigree and mate selection or for any advice regarding the breeding of
 Lupine Dogs.
- You will be able to register offspring from your Foundation Dog with W.O.L.F. provided the dam of the litter has full W.O.L.F. Lupine or Foundation Dog registration. The sire should ideally be a registered Lupine or Foundation Dog but can be an outside stud. Outside studs must provide proof of all the required health testing for W.O.L.F. registered dogs including Embarkvet DNA screening.
- Puppy owners will receive a pedigree certificate with W.O.L.F. registration by official stamp, puppy welcome pack and access to our advice services and online community. Plus, one year's free general membership with W.O.L.F.
- Your dog will be eligible to enter the Registered Lupine Dog classes at our conformation shows.
- Your dog's basic info can be displayed on our website and media as proof of their quality.

Is my dog eligible?

Registration is open to natural type dogs with a minimum of 3-generation pedigree/lineage information.

- Any natural type dog breed may be eligible if they achieve 70% or more of our Lupine Dog Breed Standard
- The owner must be a Breeder Member of W.O.L.F.
- A maximum hip dysplasia score of B/B FCI or BVA, OFA equivalent. PennHIP ≥0.30
- A clear elbow dysplasia score of 0/0
- SOD1 (Degenerative Myelopathy) result clear or carrier (NOTE: CARRIERS will only be eligible for puppy registration if bred with a CLEAR mate)
- LHX3 (Pituitary Dwarfism) or where required OSD3 (Oculoskeletal Dysplasia) result clear or carrier (NOTE: CARRIER offspring will only be eligible for puppy registration if bred with a CLEAR mate)
- A clear eye examination by a Veterinary Ophthalmologist or via DNA results
- An Embarkvet Genetic Test to include Breed Identification
- A pass result of the W.O.L.F. Temperament and Behaviour Evaluation
- The breeder/member/owner must abide by our 'Code of Ethics'

How to apply: The Dog Assessment Process:

- Before you can register your dog, you a breeder must be a 'Breeder Member' of W.O.L.F. with a registered Affix (Kennel Name)
- You must make yourself aware of the W.O.L.F. Lupine Dog Breed Standard, Code of Ethics and our Constitution, all of which can be found on our website, and you must have a valid W.O.L.F. breeder membership. CAUTION: breaches in our Codes of Ethics will be taken very seriously and may result in removal of member certification and/or dog registration
- With your veterinarian, fill in the form included in this pack
- You must provide verifiable evidence that your dog has passed a variety of health tests Please Note: Although it can be done at home, ideally, we require any DNA swab to be done by your veterinarian to verify the dog's identity and W.O.L.F. reserve the right to request this action if concerns are raised over the authentication of any DNA results.

Complete and return the attached form together with copies of health certification, full Emarkvet report, known 3-generation pedigree and Lupine Temperament/Behaviour Evaluation, back to us with a one-off £20.00 GBP application fee. Transfer of ownership will incur admin fees.
